## **MINISTRY UPDATES**

### **Vicarage Program**

The Lord has seen fit to not provide us the opportunity to host a vicar in the Spring, 2023 assignments. With only 35 vicars available, there were about a dozen congregations who applied and did not receive one. While we are disappointed at a missed opportunity, we will look for the blessings God has in store for us in this. Next spring, the situation expects to be reversed as there will be 55 vicars needing assignments. So, even if all the same congregations apply next year, they will still need more host sites. We should keep this in mind as we plan for the future.

### **175th Anniversary Sanctuary “Refresh”**

Based on the forums held last year, we will begin the process of planning to update a number of aspects of our historic sanctuary. Planning and evaluation will lead to proposals being presented to the congregation for action. Whatever needs are identified and solutions proposed, rest assured, the character and dignity of God’s House here in Valley City will endure.

### **Rev. Chris Streeper**

Rev. Streeper continues to progress through his colloquy (certification) process toward being a Lutheran pastor. It has been a blessing to have him as a partner in the Gospel these several months as he and his family become familiar parts of our life together here at St. Paul. Several future ministry opportunities have begun to take shape, so please keep him in your prayers as the Lord lays out the call for his ministry. In the meantime, we will begin to provide preaching opportunities and enjoy the blessings of his God-given gifts and talents.

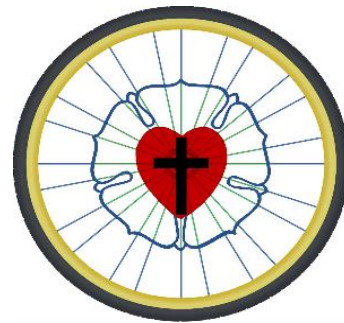
